There were valuable papers from the University of Texas on Biodiversity and Bio-culture by Sahorta Sarkar. Prof Dr. S Khanna also contributed a wonderful and informative paper on Video endoscopic treatment of complex anal fistula . The first issue of the Journal was also augmented by the sociological article by Lynn Janieson of the University of Edinburg , United Kingdom and thus the journal tried its best to maintain the International Standard. The Clarion was started as a bi yearly journal under the authority of Director of Centre for Environment, Education and Economic Development, an organisation under then Planning Commission , Govt. of India. The Clarion had earned a great exposure in almost all the indexing data bases of the world including University of Harvard, Cornell University, University of London etc. This was the only Journal of this North Eastern Region where academicians , researchers , students and people from all walks of life could put their views to the greater academic world. In 2013 the University Grands Commission endorsed this journal and thus this journal could establish itself in the academic world of the country. But in 2018 May, several thousand Journals were removed from the UGC list of Journals and this Journal was also not an exception. But with the goodwill of the people of this country and abroad this Journal could survive and maintain its academic standard. During the time of Covid, in the year 2021, we could publish only one issue due to different constrains.

This year of 2022 The Journal could complete ten years of its existence and the editorial board is happy to publish some selected articles as a celebration of the DECADE of The Clarion.

The Clarion has completed a long untiring journey of uninterrupted publication and is today at the top of Indian Multidisciplinary journals with thousands of citations . Thanks to our contributors, readers, reviewers, editorial team and Editorial Board members, the Clarion has been able to publish '*good*' articles. Being the only Multidisciplinary journal of this region and still being at the top of its class adds another feather in the cap of this prestigious *Journal*.
